A match which was won by the better side due to a couple of brilliant strikes but Amersham didn't help themselves with lots of defensive mistakes. After a dominant first half performance, Broadfields led 2-0. Amersham seemed to control some of the second half. However they were unable to convert any of this possession and Broadfields were clinical on the counter scoring 2 exceptional goals taking the scoreline to 4-0.

First Half

Broadfields made a strong start, creating a few early half-chances, while Amersham defended well in the opening stages. Naz Miah came close with a brilliant strike from the edge of the box that rattled the crossbar.

Broadfields took the lead in the 13th minute after sustained pressure Arif Bala beat his defender down the left wing, sent the ball across the box, and when Amersham failed to clear, Gabriel Piotrowski whipped in a superb cross for Ricardo lopes de Matos to head past the Matt Messer for 1–0.

Amersham nearly equalised soon after when Joshua Clay beat two defenders on the right and crossed for Dominic Jones , who should have scored, but the effort was easily saved. Broadfields continued to threaten, particularly from set pieces, and dominated possession, creating several good chances.

Joshua Clay was sin-binned for dissent after reacting to a decision for a foul, leaving Amersham temporarily a man down.

Just before the break, Broadfields doubled their lead. A flowing move saw Matheus Santana receive the ball on the right edge of the box, lay it off to Abdirahman Ahmed, who slid a clever pass to Arif Bala. His shot deflected off a defender, struck the inside of the post, and rolled into the net to make it 2–0 at half-time.

Half-Time: Broadfields 2–0 Amersham

Broadfields dominated the first 45, controlling possession and capitalising on their chances, while Amersham struggled to create anything clear-cut.

Second Half

Amersham began the second half positively, enjoying most of the possession and forcing Broadfields to defend deep.

However, Broadfields remained dangerous on the counter, and in the 53rd minute they struck again. Matheus Santana picked up the ball on the halfway line, drove into the box, and his deflected pass found Ricardo lopes de Mata, who side-footed home into the top corner for 3–0.

A defensive mix-up saw Joshua Quadry fail to clear his lines, allowing Arif Bala to win the ball and earn a free kick on the edge of the area. He then curled the set piece beautifully into the top right corner to make it 4-0 to Broadfields United

Full-Time: Broadfields 4–0 Amersham

Amersham enjoyed more of the ball in the second half but couldn't create any clear scoring opportunities. Broadfields were clinical on the counter and punished defensive errors with ruthless attacking moves, capped by a moment of brilliance from Arif Bala.

Next weekend Amersham travel to face Wallingford & Crowmarsh.
